The taking, or attempting to take, anything of value under confrontational circumstances from the control, custody, or care of another person by force or threat of force or violence and/or putting the victim in fear or immediate harm.

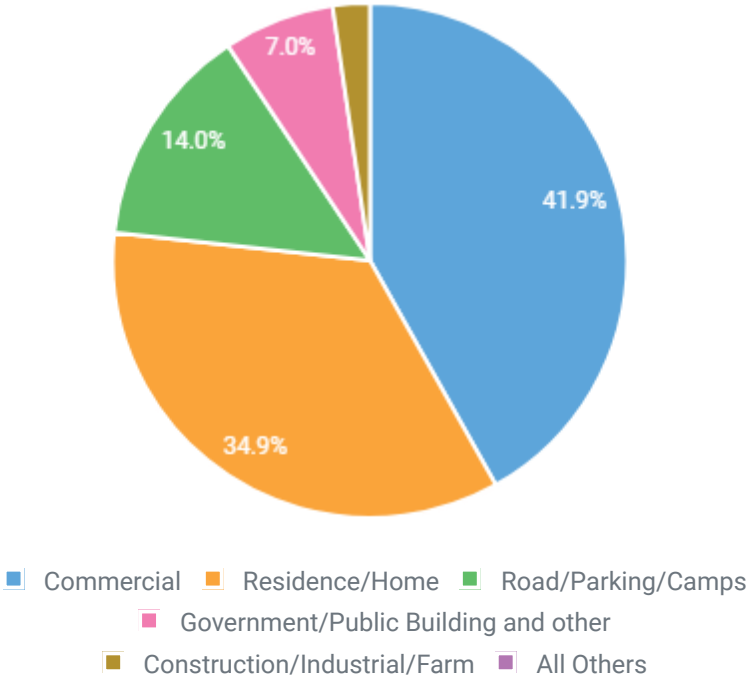

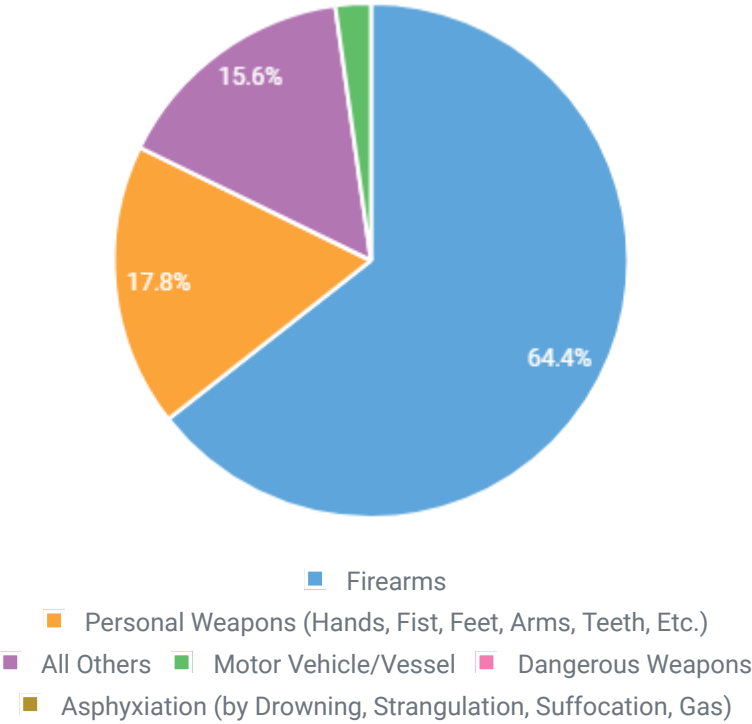
### LOCATION

Top 5 location types for robbery offenses



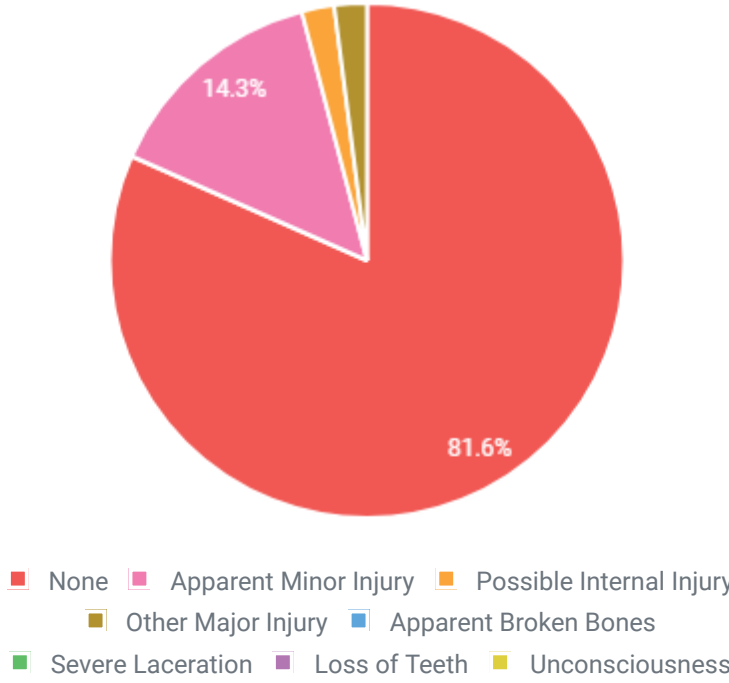
### WEAPON USED

Top 5 weapons used to commit robbery



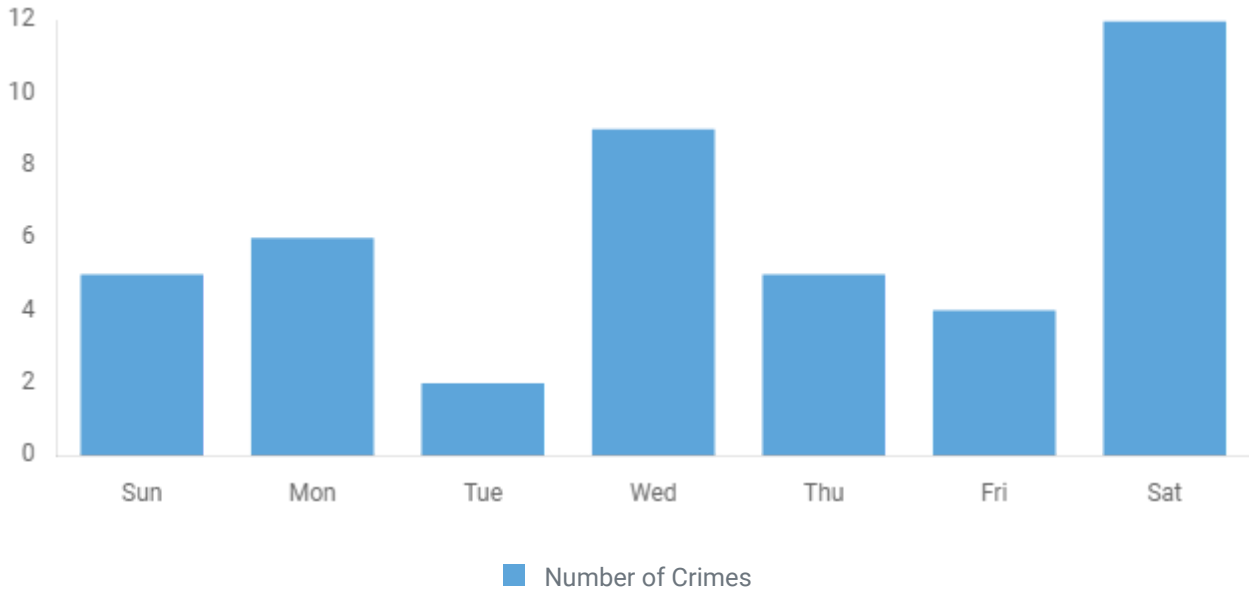
### VICTIM INJURY TYPE

Injuries resulting from robbery



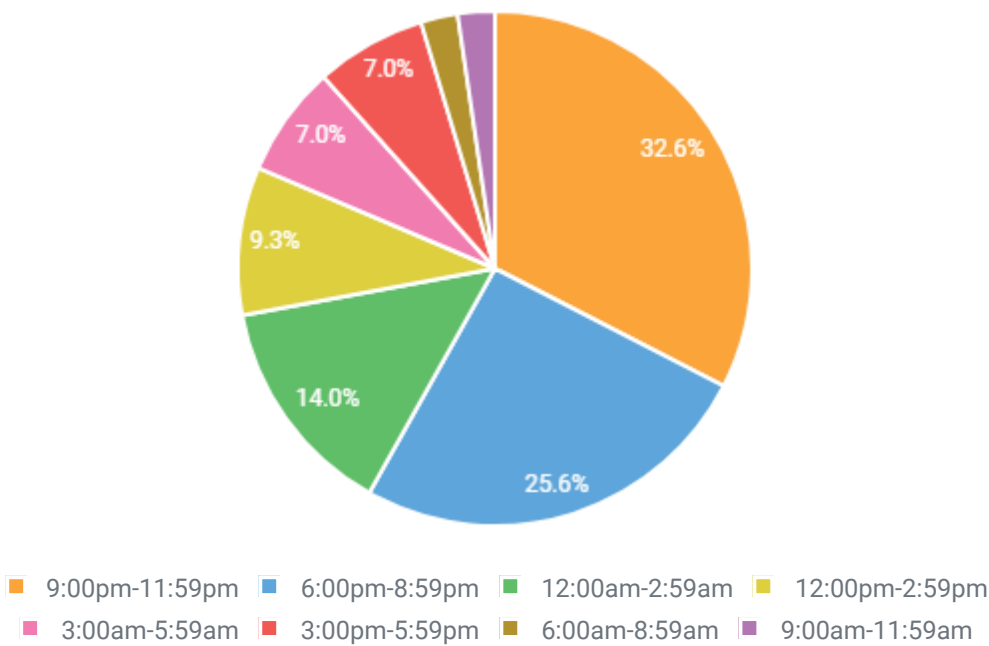

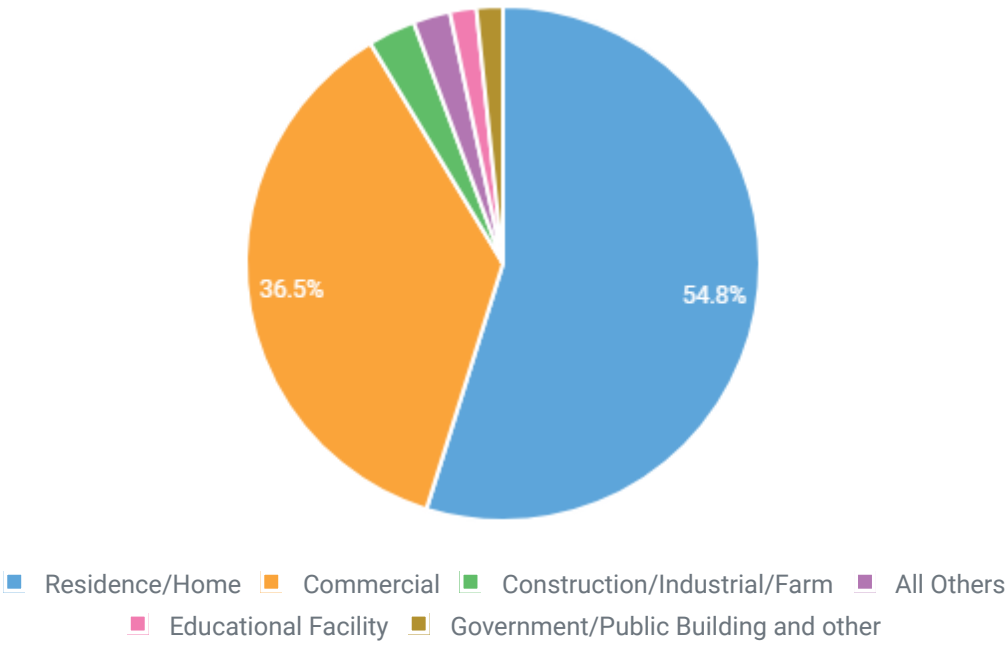

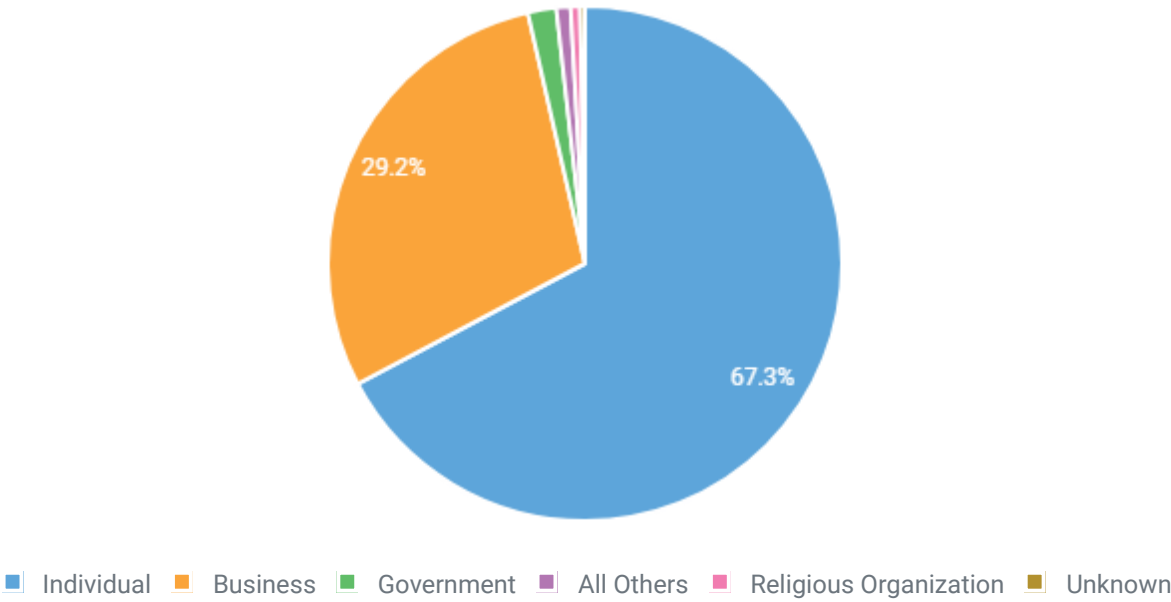
## LOCATION

Top 5 location types for burglary offenses



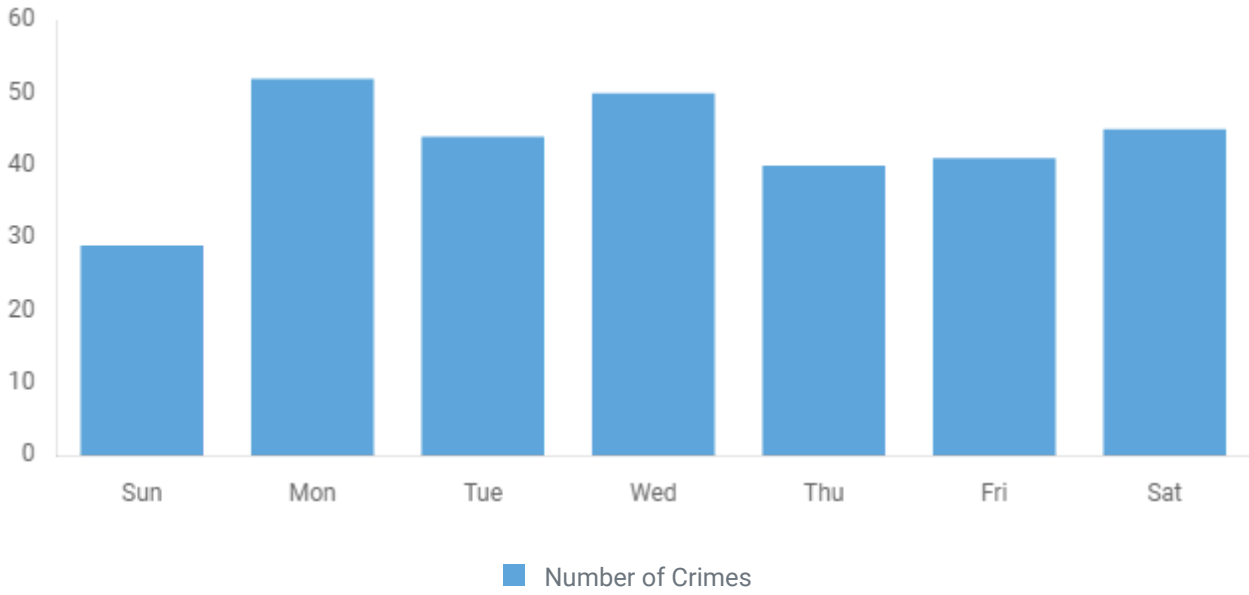

Victims of burglary offenses



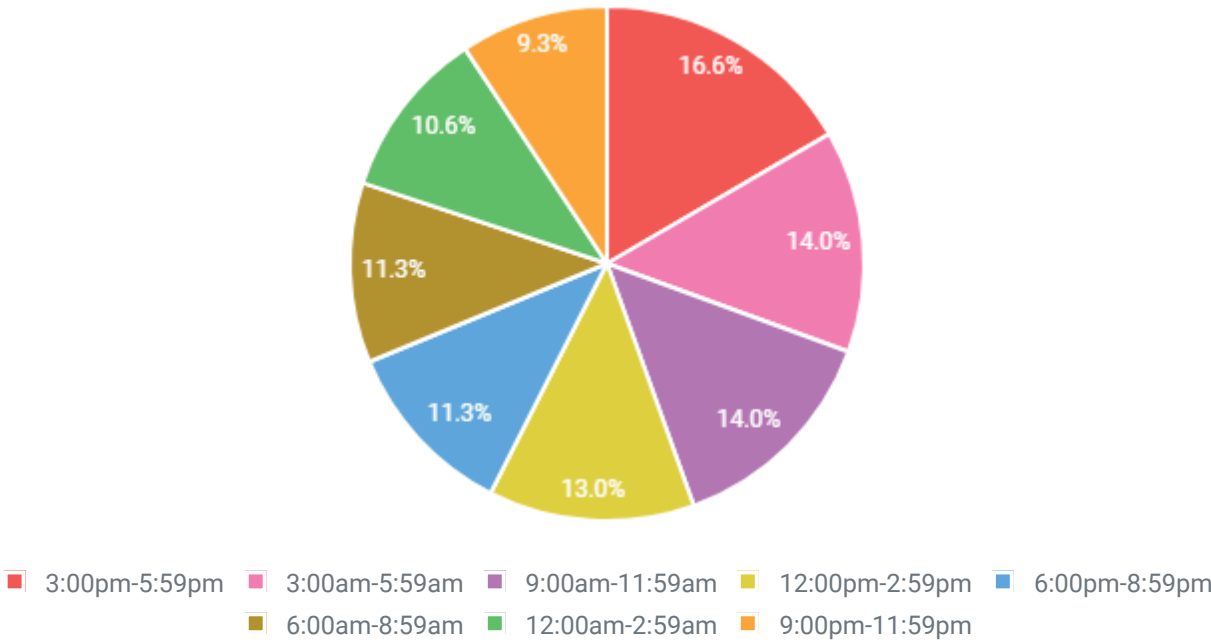

Crimes: 2,666      Clearance Rate: 29.48%

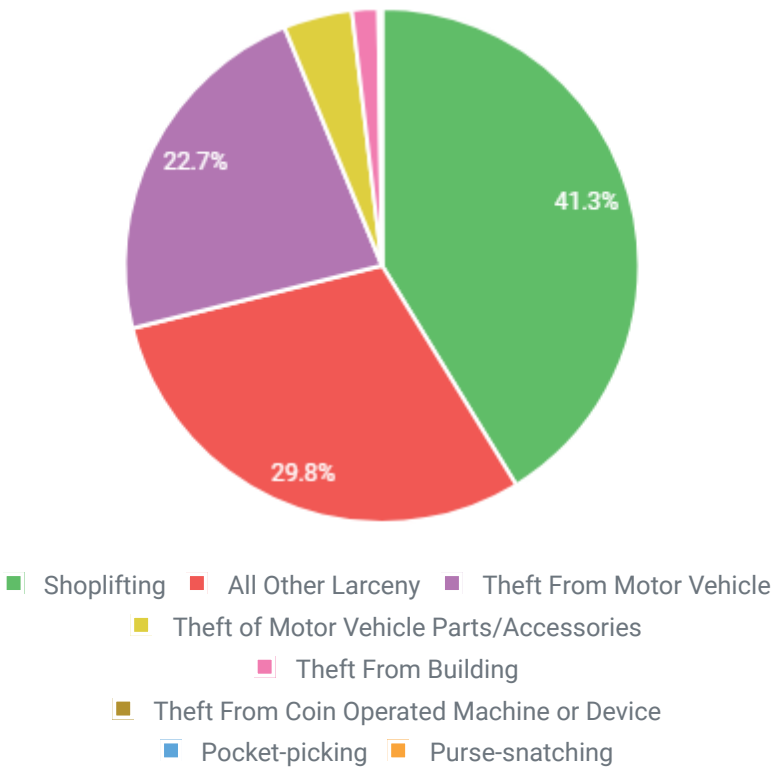

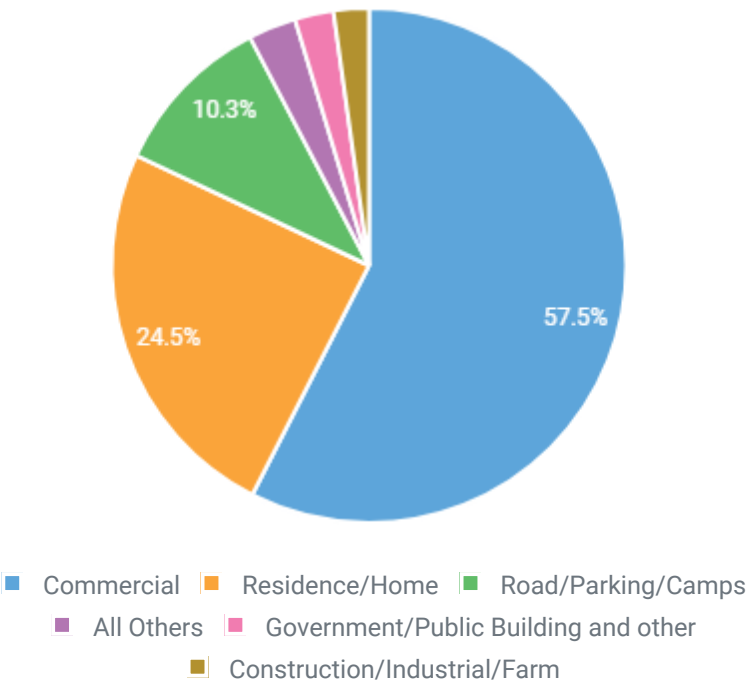
### OFFENSE COMMITTED

Offenses included in the theft category



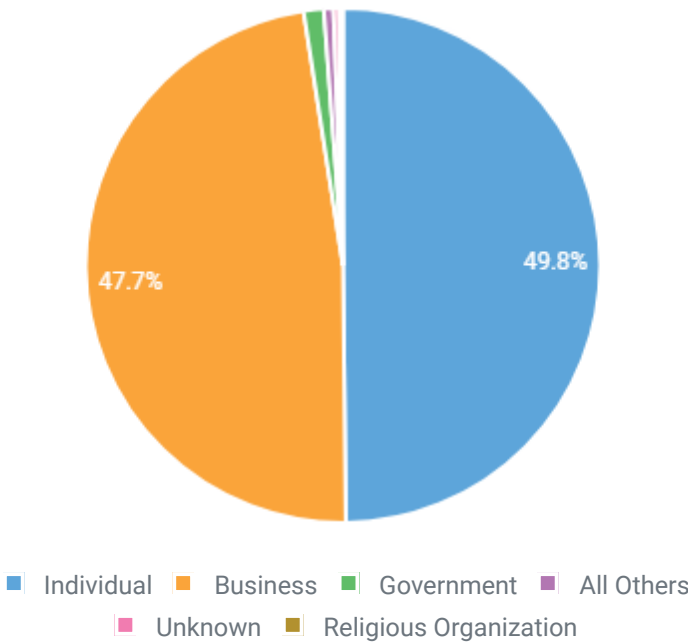
### LOCATION

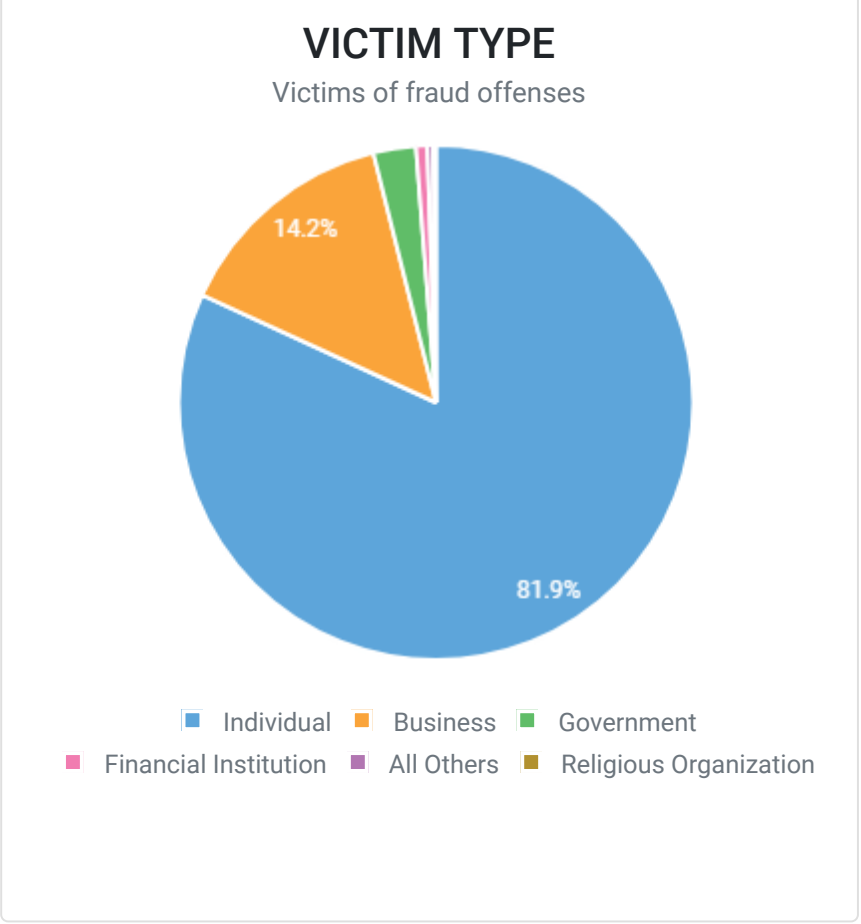
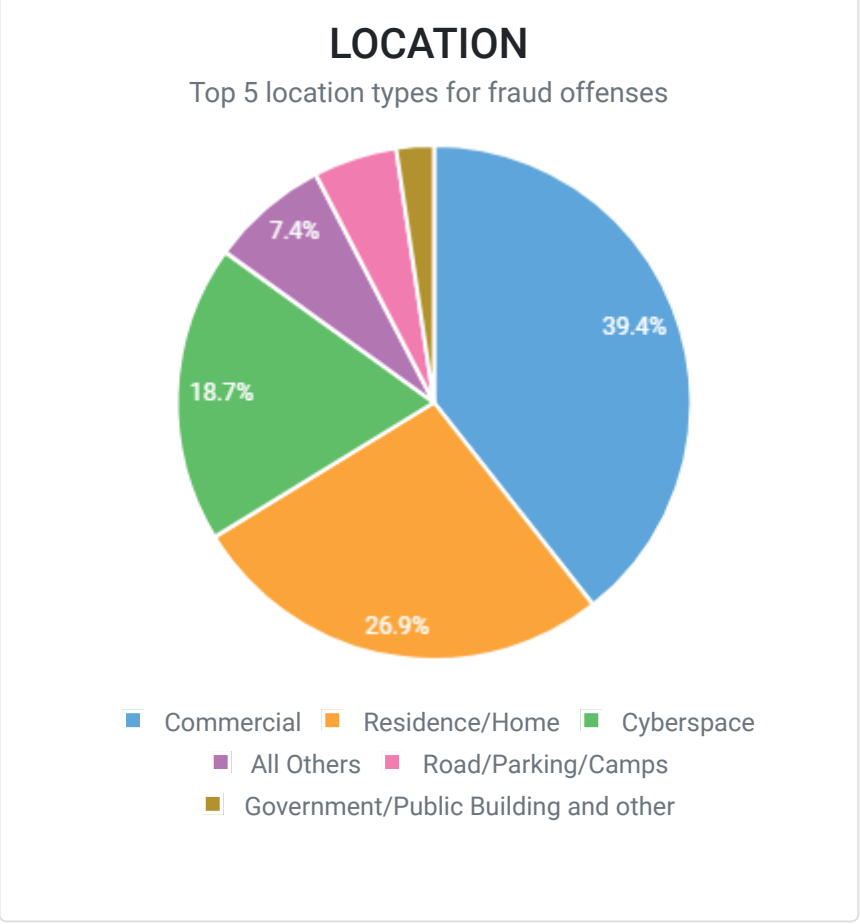
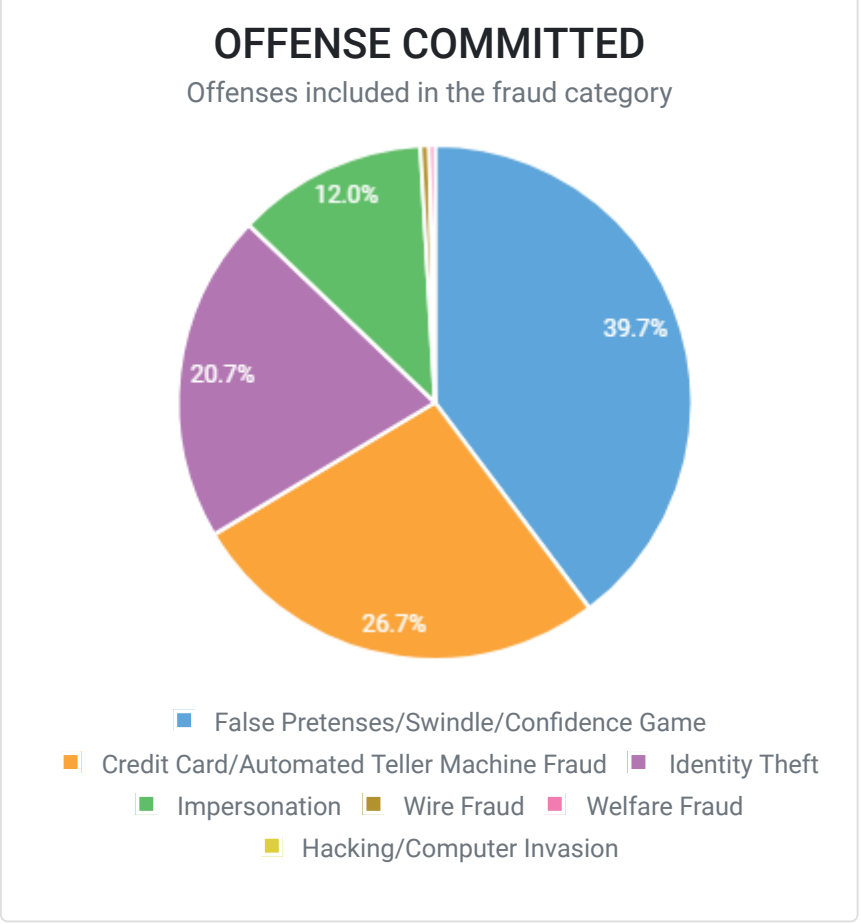
The intentional perversion of the truth for the purpose of inducing another person, or other entity, in reliance upon it to part with something of value or to surrender a legal right.

Crimes: 126

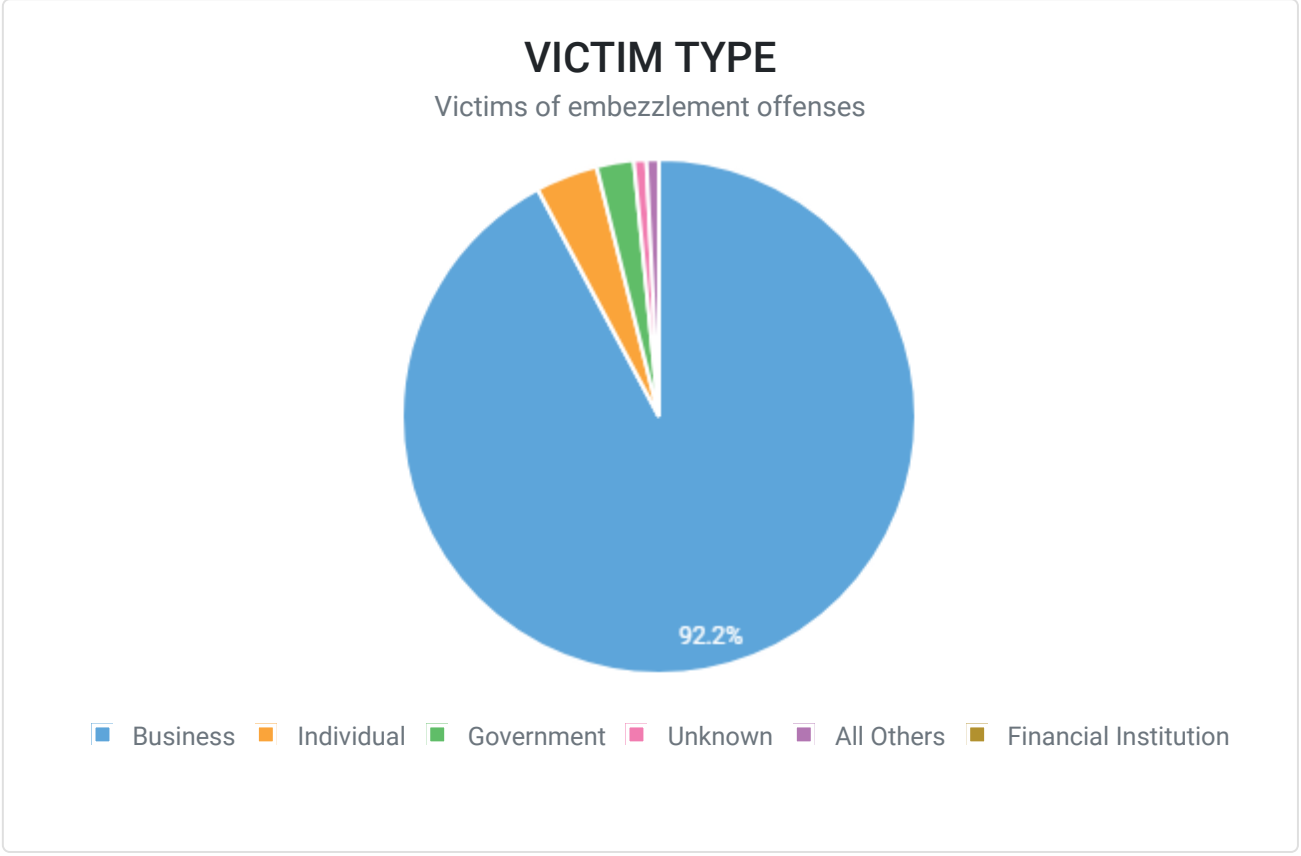
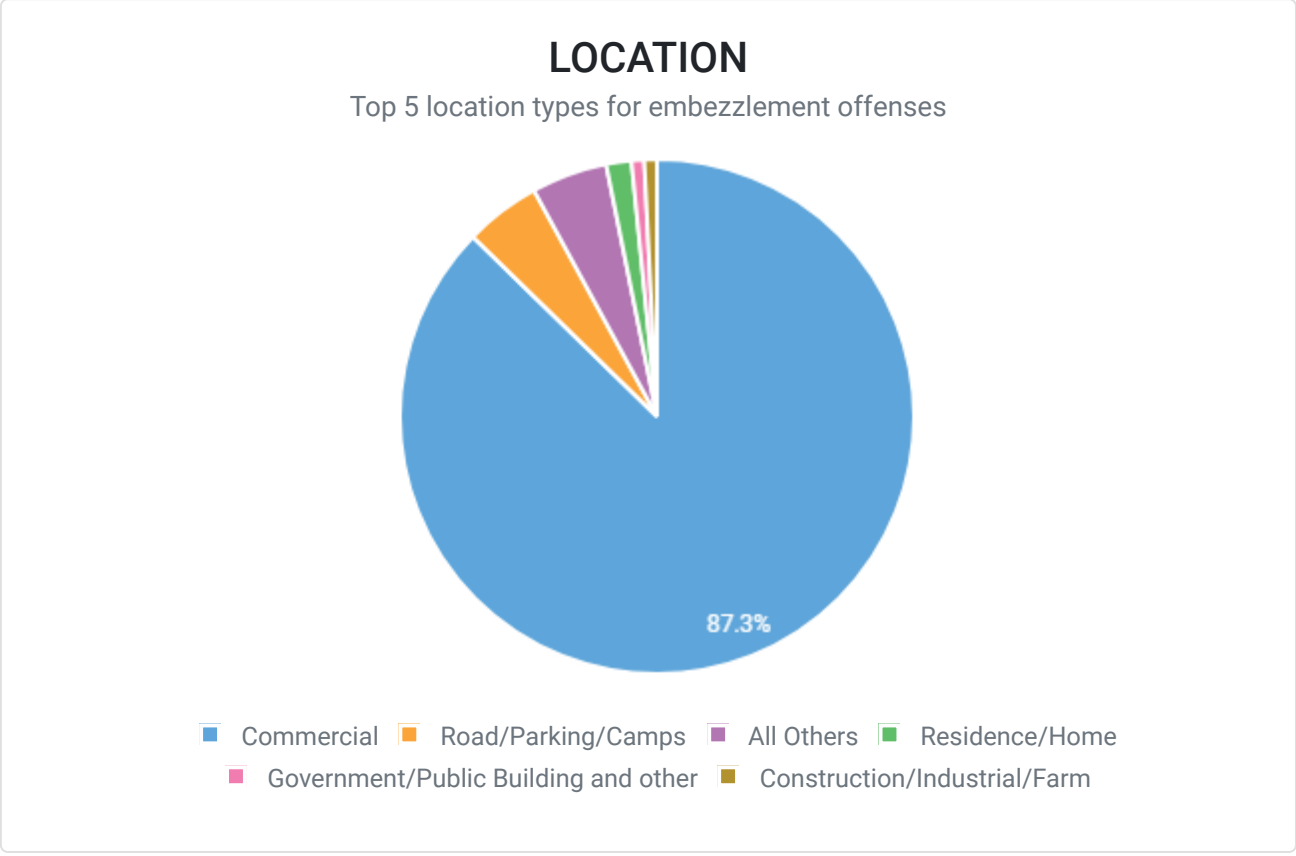

Crimes: 628      Clearance Rate: 8.92%

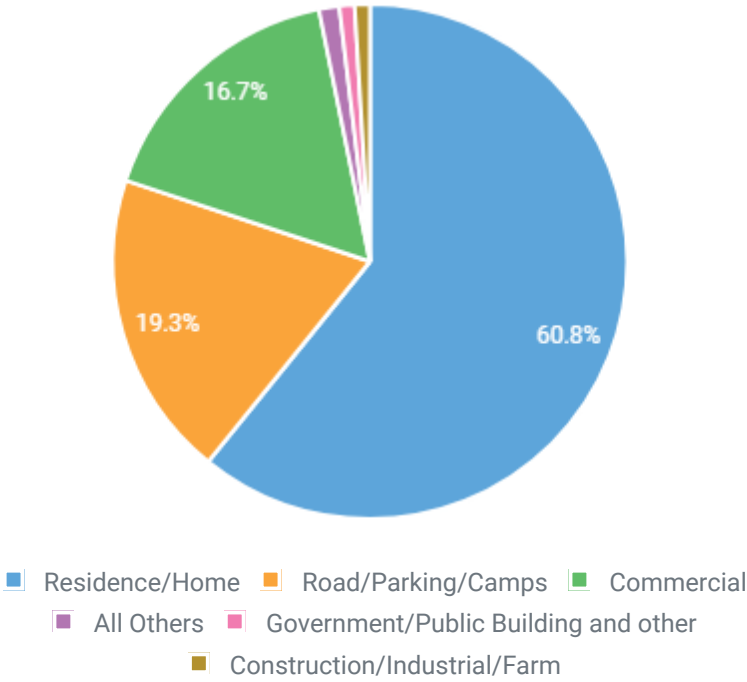

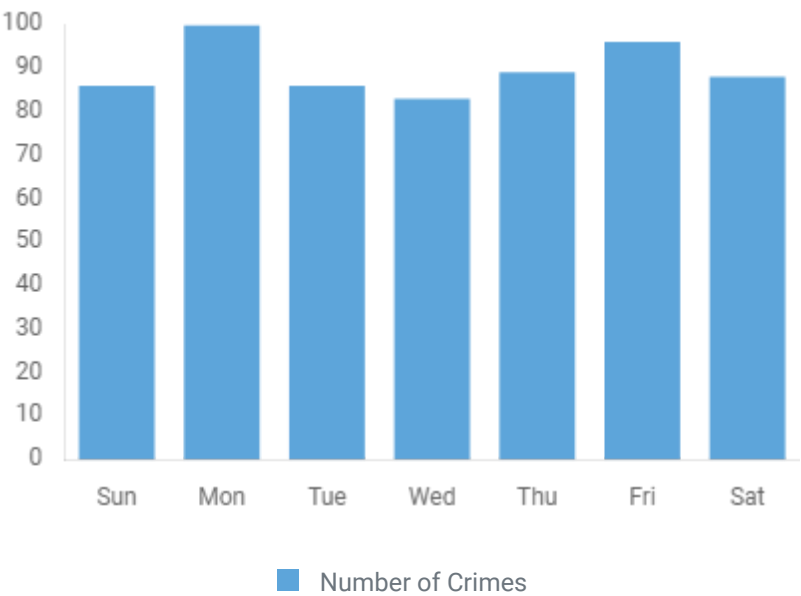
### LOCATION

Top 5 location types for motor vehicle theft



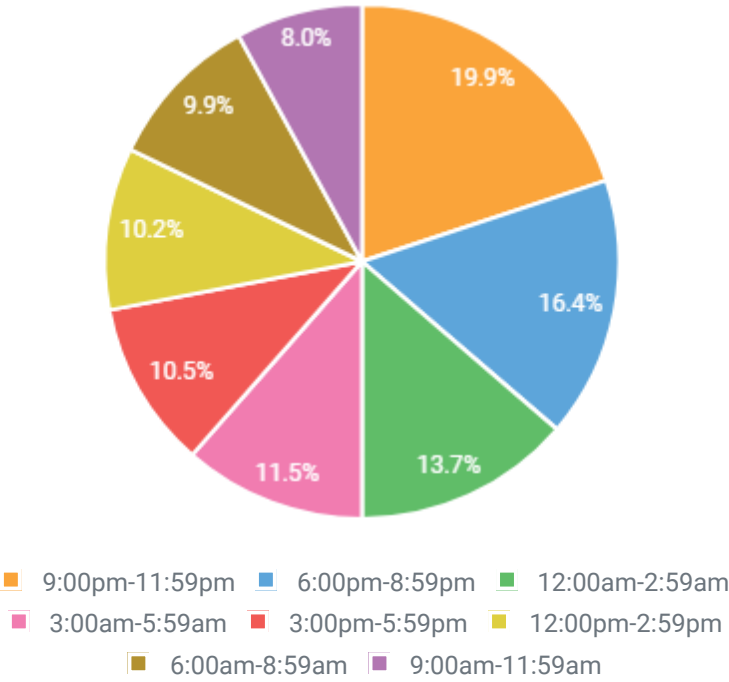

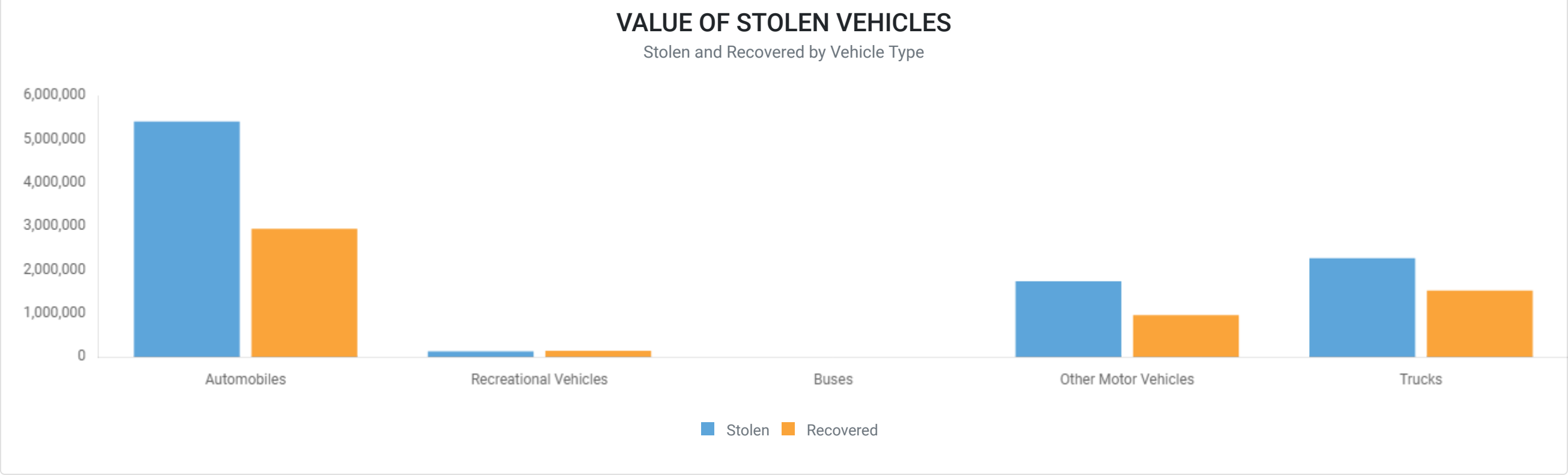
Motor Vehicle Theft
