Violent Crime consists of Murder, Non-consensual Sex Offenses, Robbery and Aggravated Assault. When counting cases below, this is the count of victims for murder, sex offenses and aggravated assault, but the count of incidents for robbery. One offense is counted for each victim.

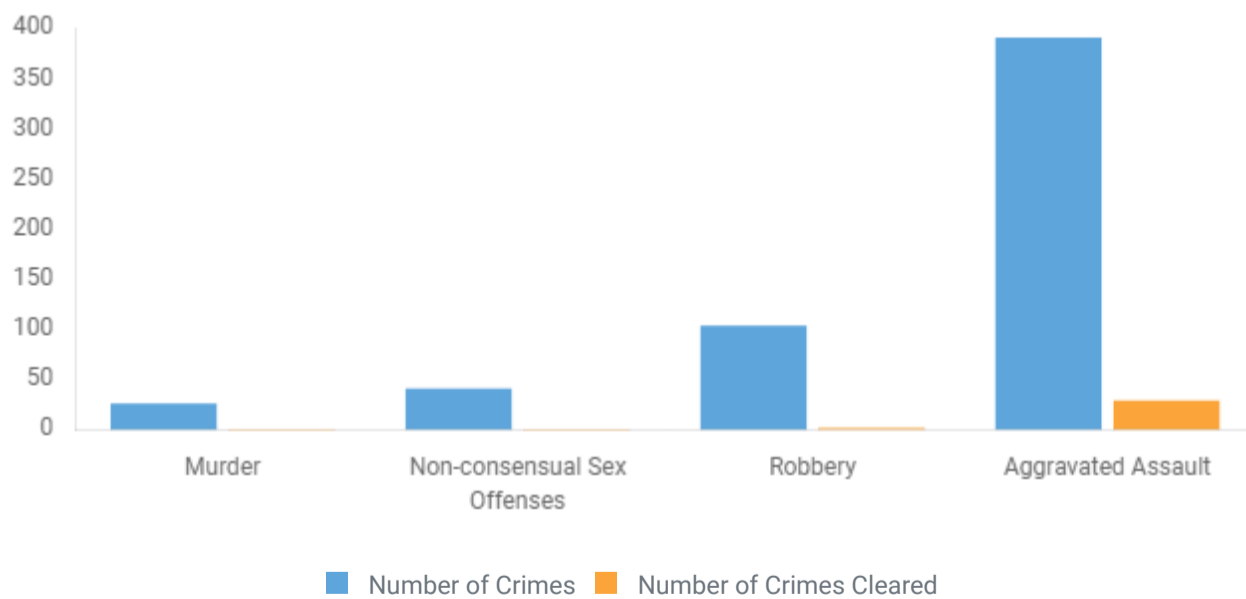

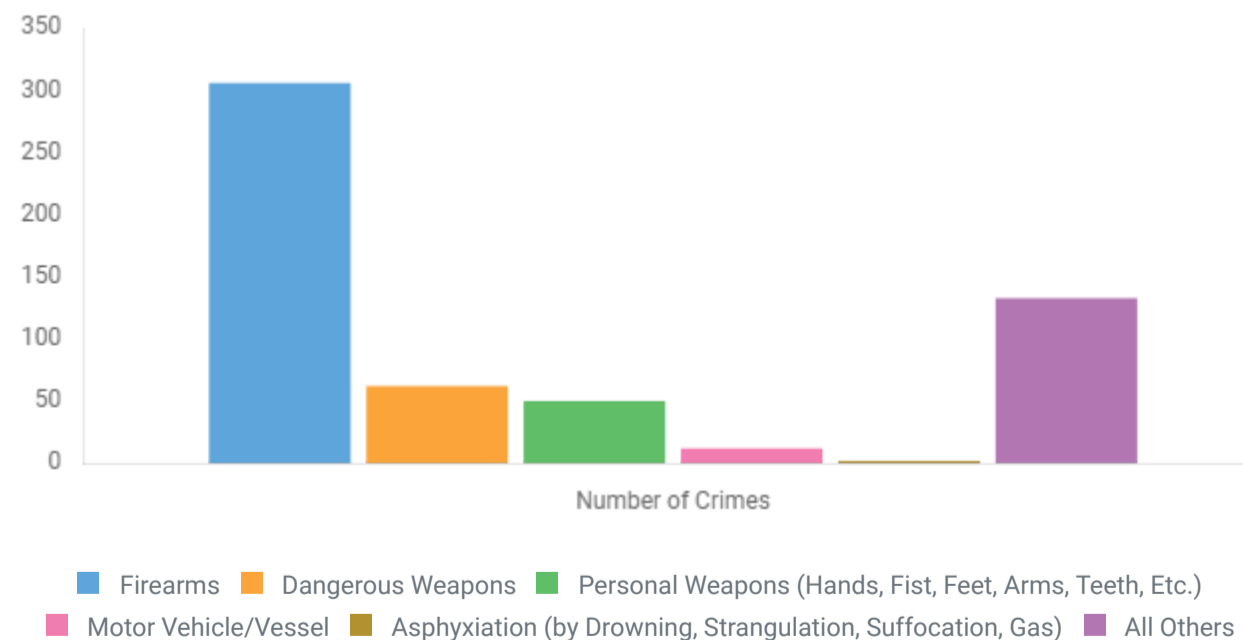

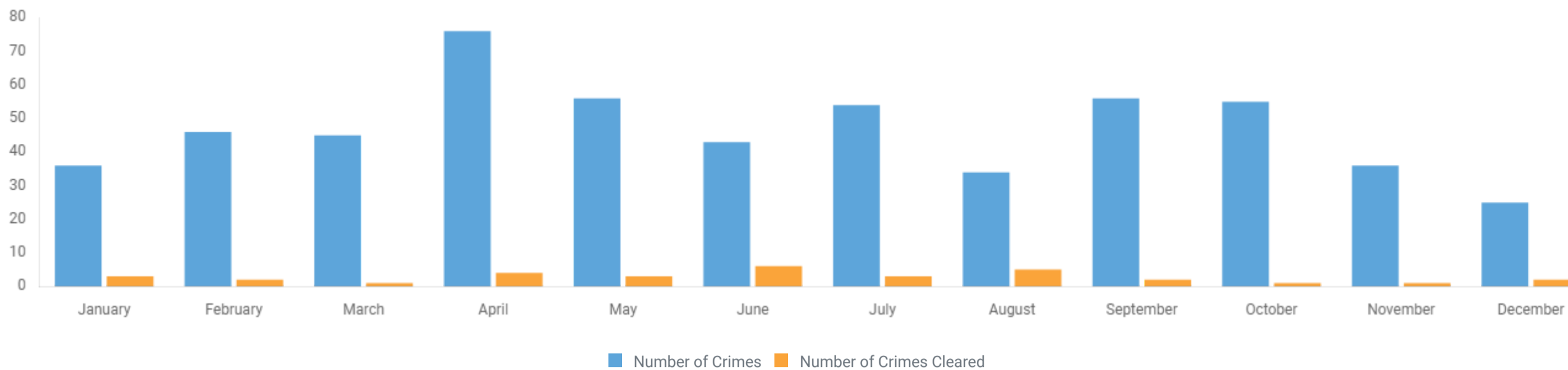

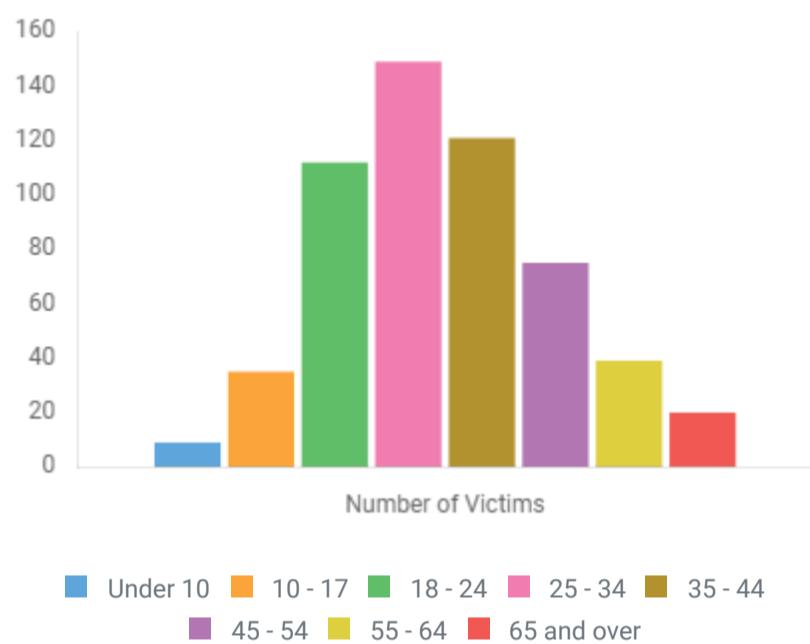
CRIMES AND CLEARANCES BY MONTH

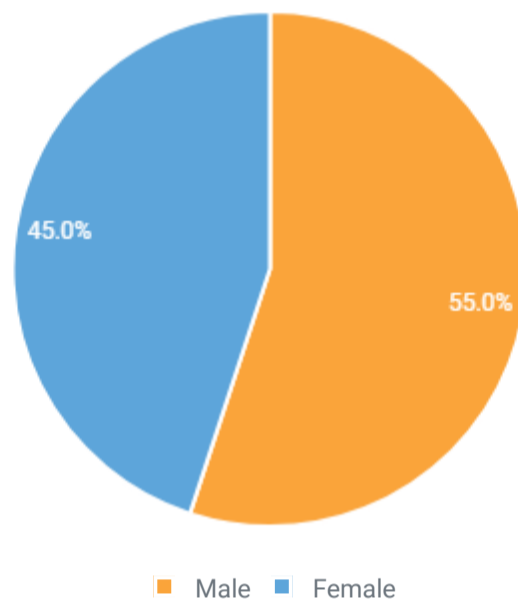
NUMBER OF VICTIMS BY AGE

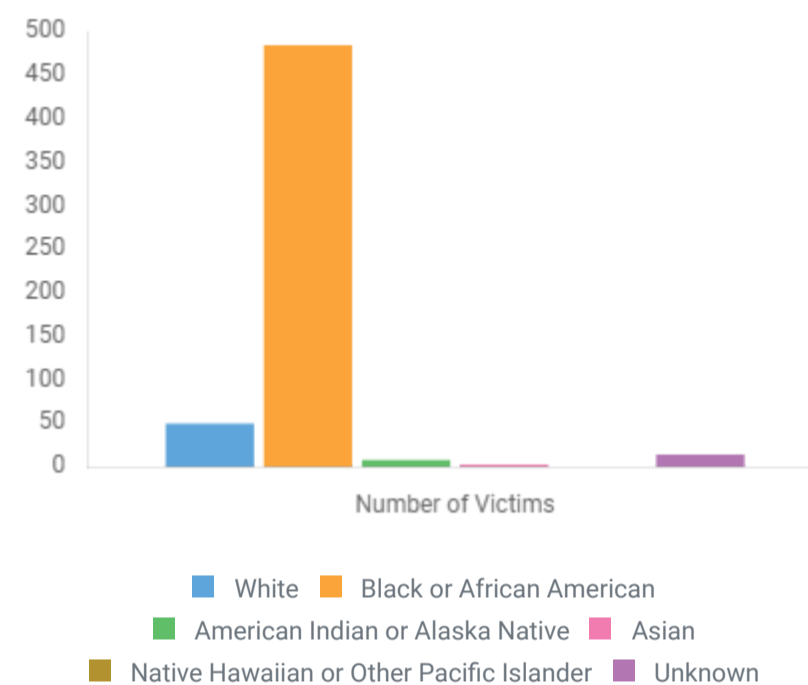
NUMBER OF VICTIMS BY SEX

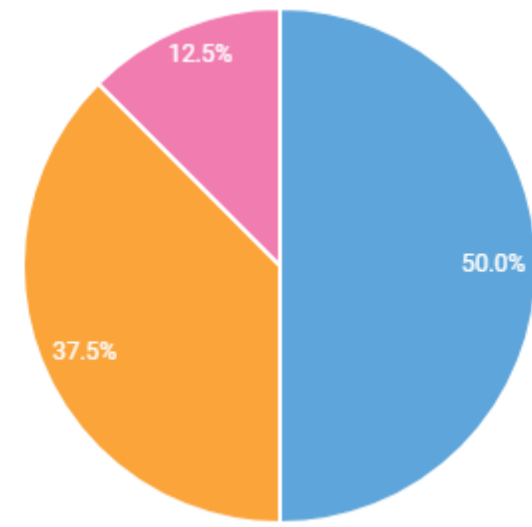

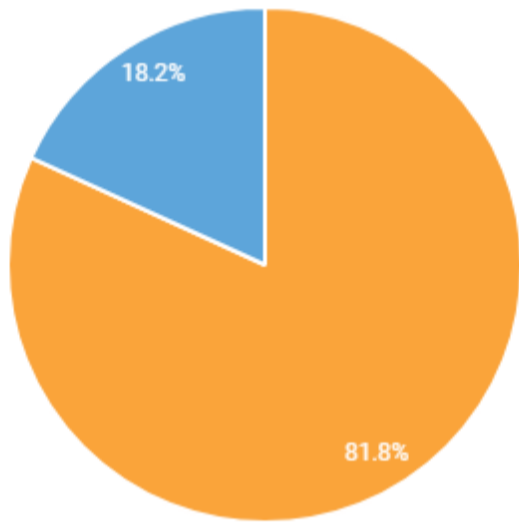

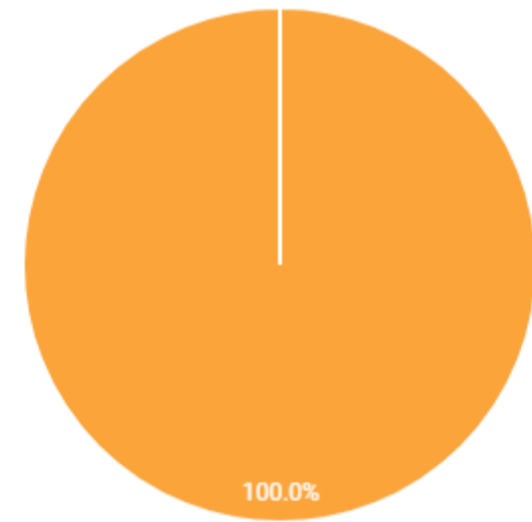

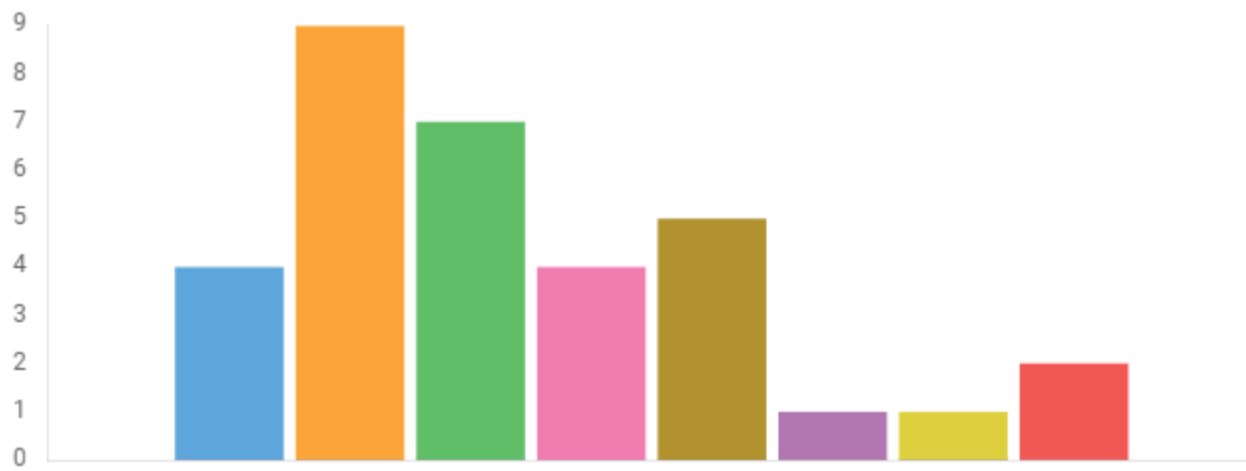

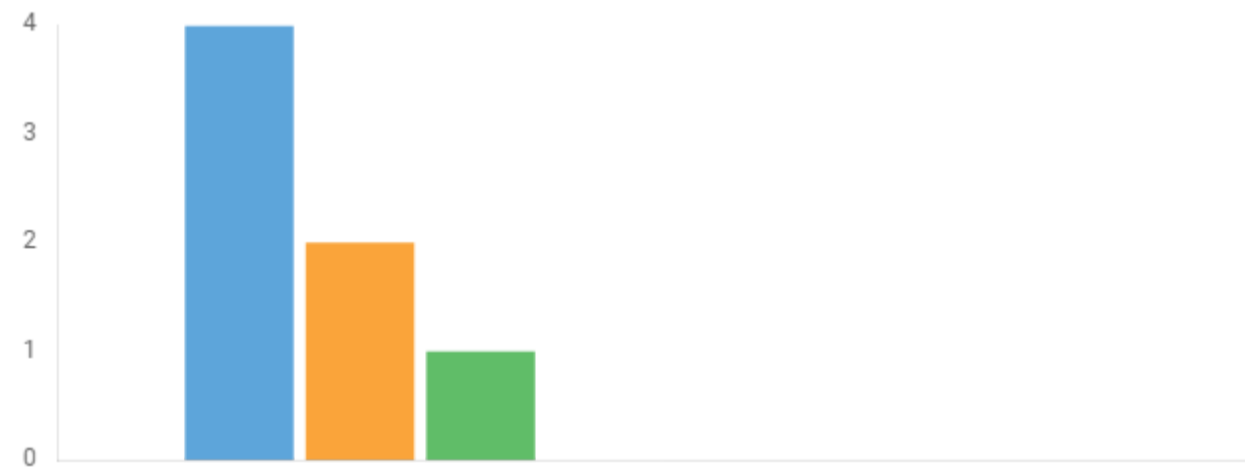


Number of Female Victims

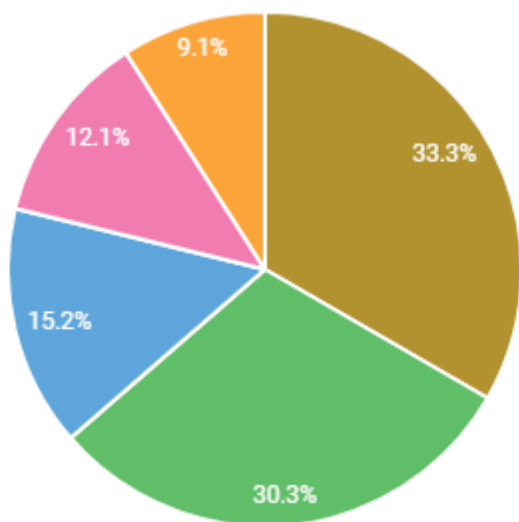


Number of Male Victims

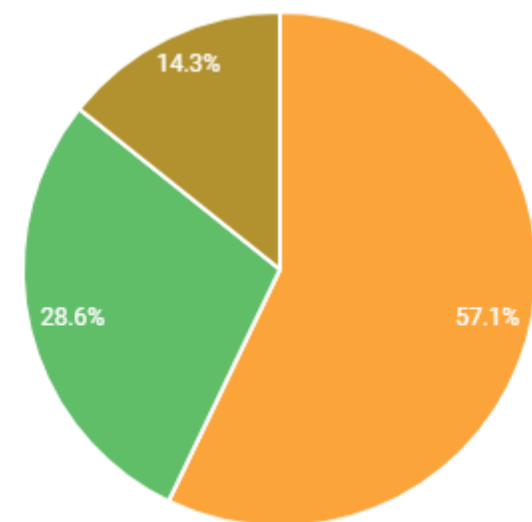

ROBBERY

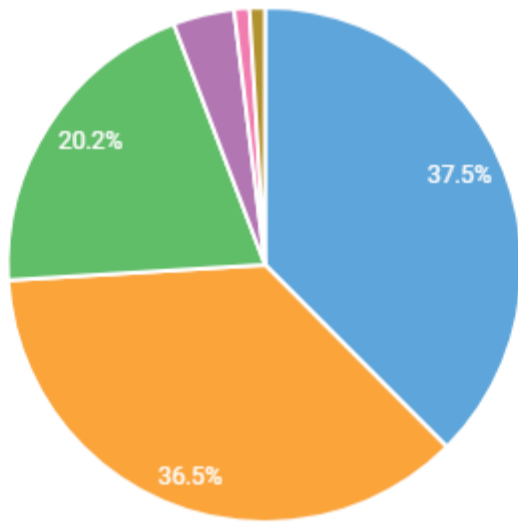

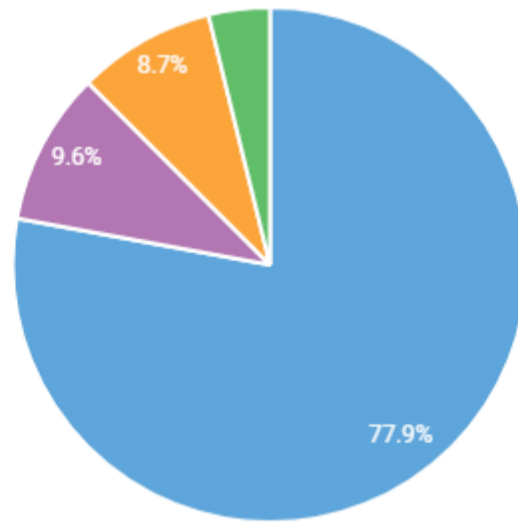

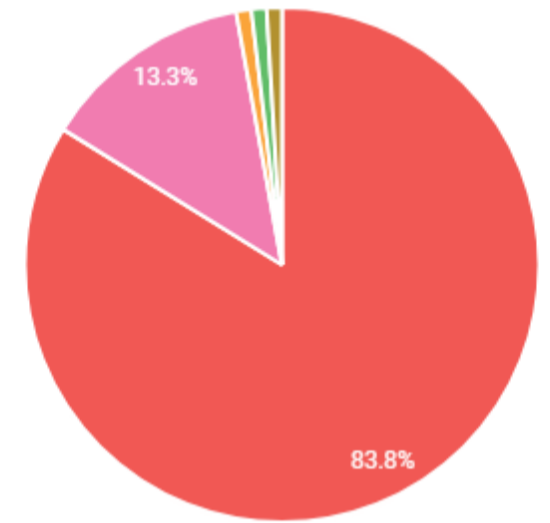

AGGRAVATED ASSAULT

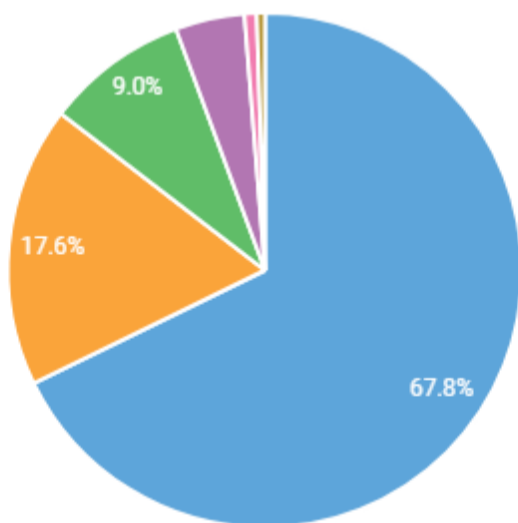
An unlawful attack by one person upon another wherein the offender uses a weapon or displays it in a threatening manner, or the victim suffers obvious severe or aggravated bodily injury involving apparent broken bones, loss of teeth, possible internal injury, severe laceration, or loss of consciousness. This also includes assault with disease (as in cases when the offender is aware that he/she is infected with a deadly disease and deliberately attempts to inflict the disease by biting, spitting, etc.).

Crimes: 391 Clearance Rate: 7.42%

A crime is cleared one of two ways: when at least one offender is arrested; or by exceptional means, when situations beyond law enforcement's control prevent the agency from arresting the offender (for example, the death of an offender).

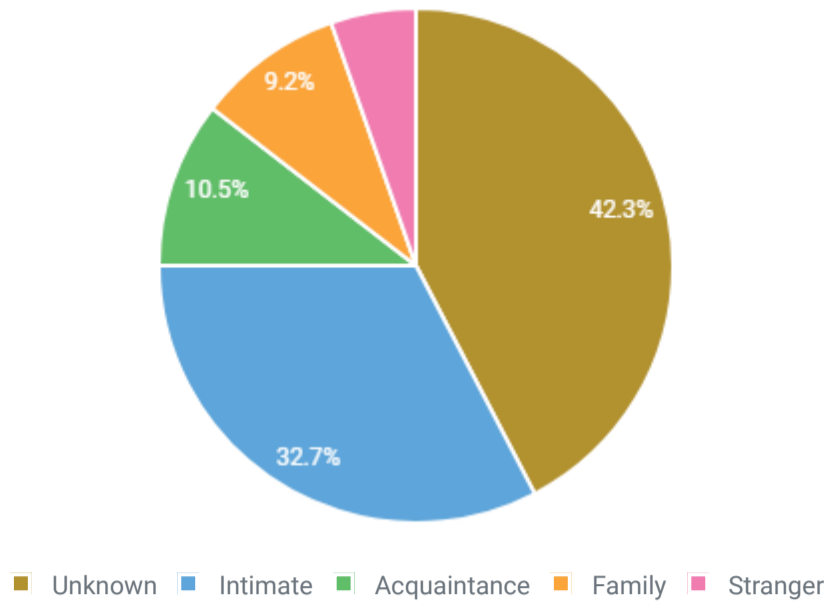

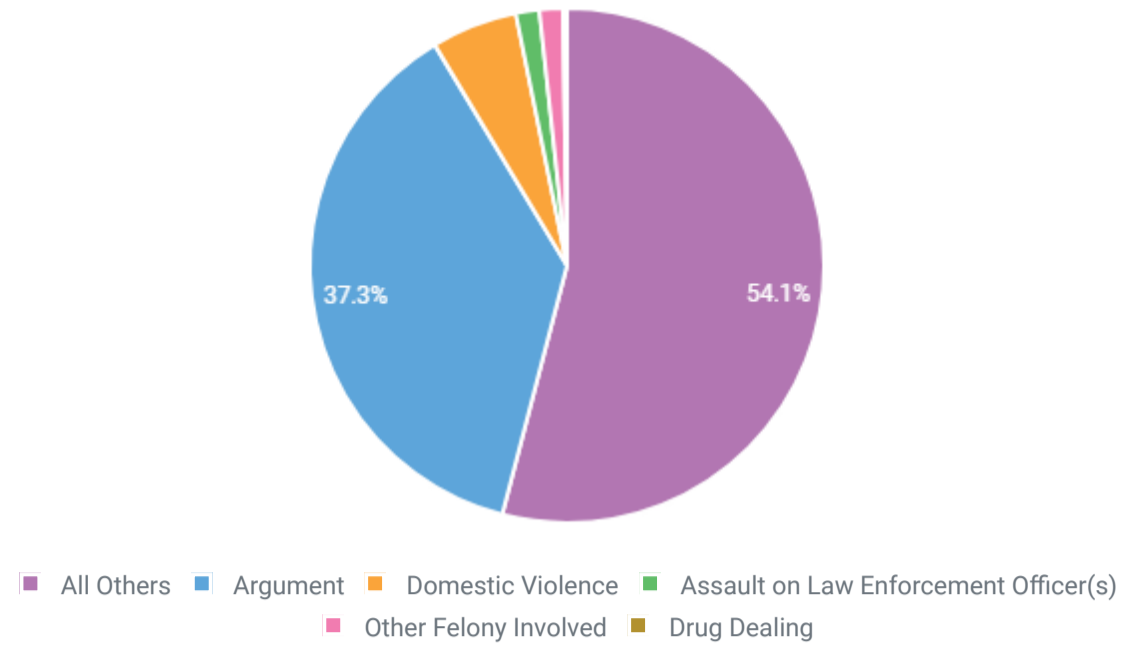

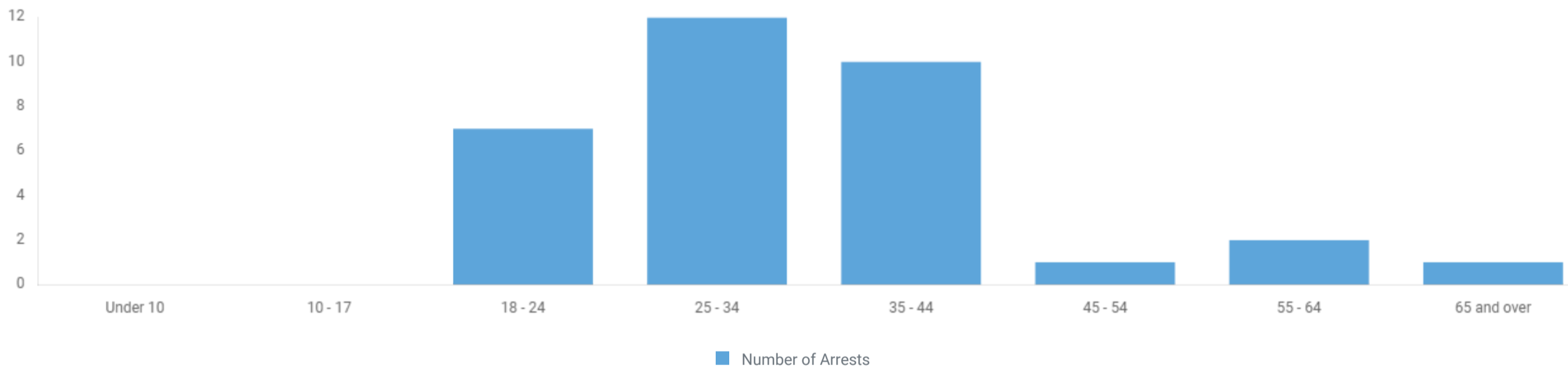

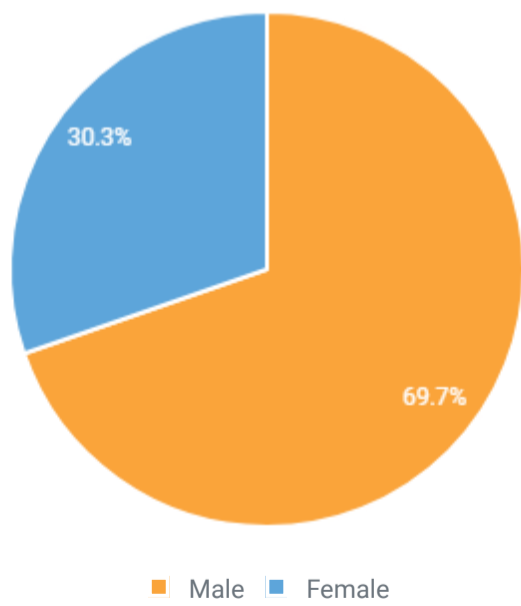
